





This was the first authentic Hindu Temple in North America built with traditional granite stones imported from India. The Temple has expanded, more than doubling in size after established originally





Śri Mahā Vallabha Ganapati Devasthānam, has established a Hindu Religious and Cultural Center Complex on Bowne Street in 4th July 1977. This street was named after John Bowne, a distinguished American who strove for religious freedom and anti-slavery movement.





# Tirupathi Balaji Temple



Lord Sri Venkateswara, also known as Srinivasa, Balaji, and Venkaṭachalapati, made Tirumala his abode five thousand years ago. Even before him, it was Lord Varahaswami who had made Tirumala his abode. The temple complex is spread over 16.2 acres of land.



Situated on the west coast of Gujarat ,this temple features in most of the legends surrounding Lord Krishna



# Dwarakadhish Temple



Archaeological findings suggest it to be 2,000 - 2,200 years old. The current temple was enlarged in 15-16th century. The temple covers area of 27-metre by 21-metre with east–west length of 29-metre and north–south width of 23 mts. The tallest peak of the temple is 51.8 m high



Situated on an elevated 15 acre plot, this 50' high temple modeled after a famous devotional palace in India called Kusum Sarovar (temple on a lake of flowers).



# Radha-Krishna Temple in Utah

Built March/April 2010



Situated on the banks of the Narmada, this temple is one of the 12 revered Jyotirlinga shrines of Shiva.



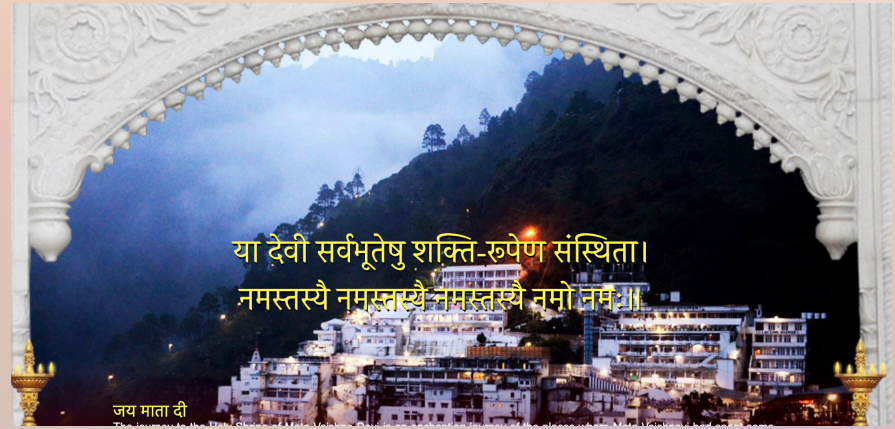

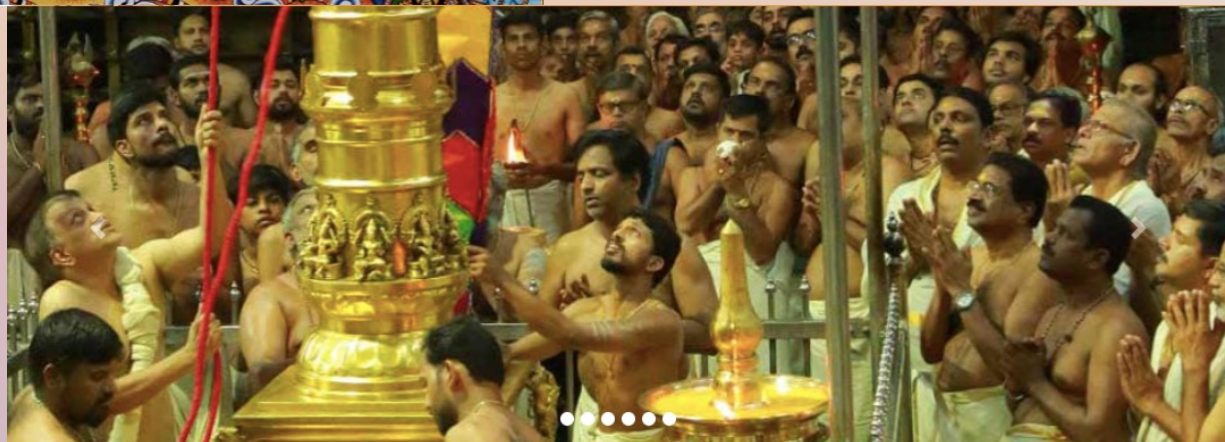

Mata Maihar

Maihar is a city situated in Satna District of Madhya Pradesh State. The name Maihar is created from the mixture of 2 words 'Mai'(Mother)+ 'Har'(Necklace). In line with the Hindu Mythology it's aforementioned that once lord Shiva was roaming while carrying the body of mother divinity Sati, the necklace (har) of divinity Sati(Mai) fell down in Maihar, therefore people started calling its name Maihar. It is also considered as one of the 51 Shakti Peeth of goddess Parvati

This temple, built around 740 A.D. by Queen Lokamahadevi to commemorate her husband's victory over the kings from the south

**Pattadakal**, also called **Paṭṭadakallu** or **Raktapura**, is a complex of 7th and 8th century CE Hindu and Jain temples in northern Karnataka (India). Located on the west bank of the Malaprabha River in Bagalakote district,
