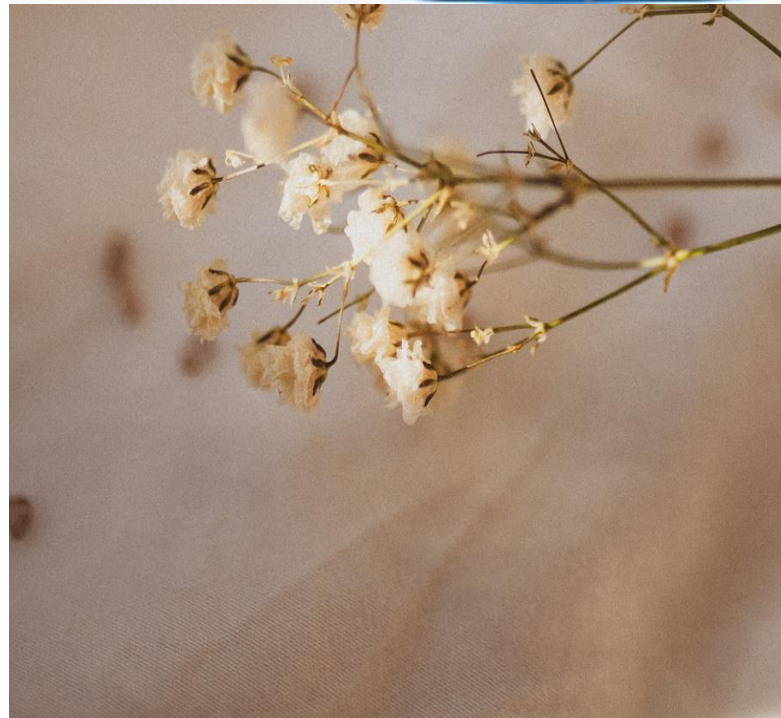

**Now We will learn the actual meaning of verse.**

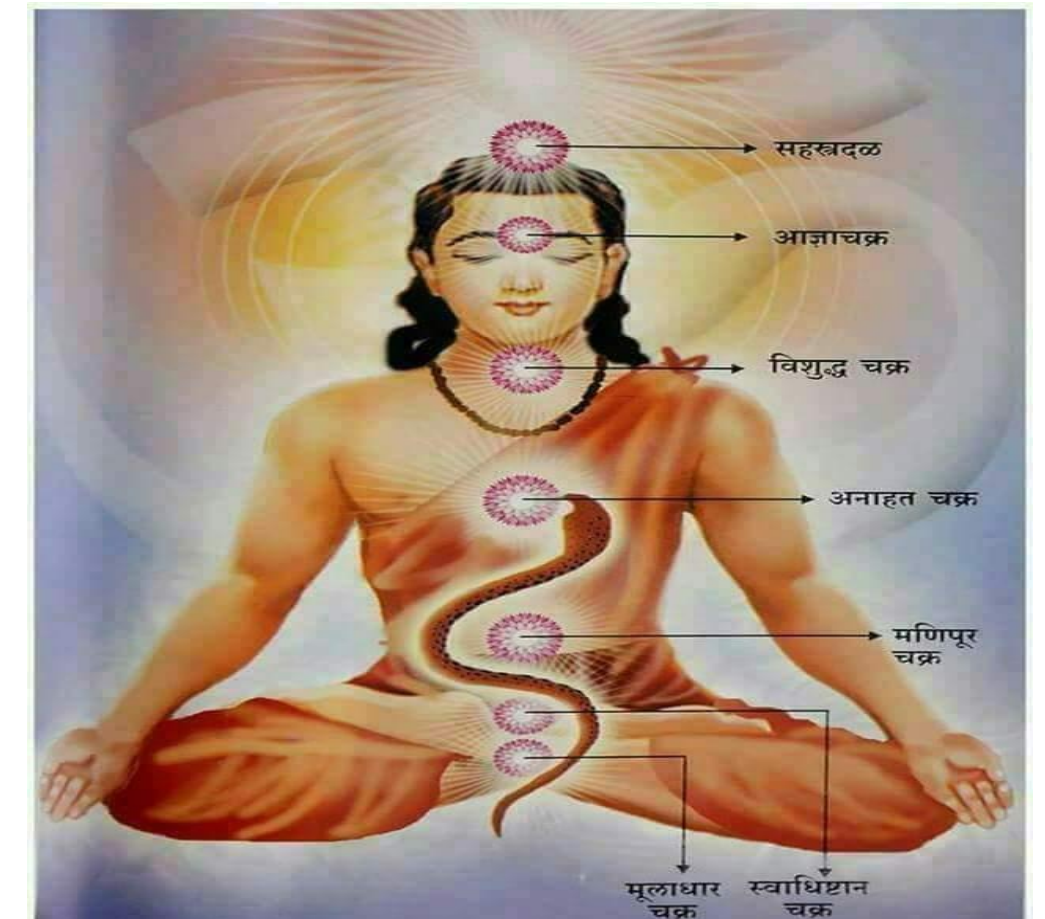
**Sah Nah Bandhuh Janitaa**

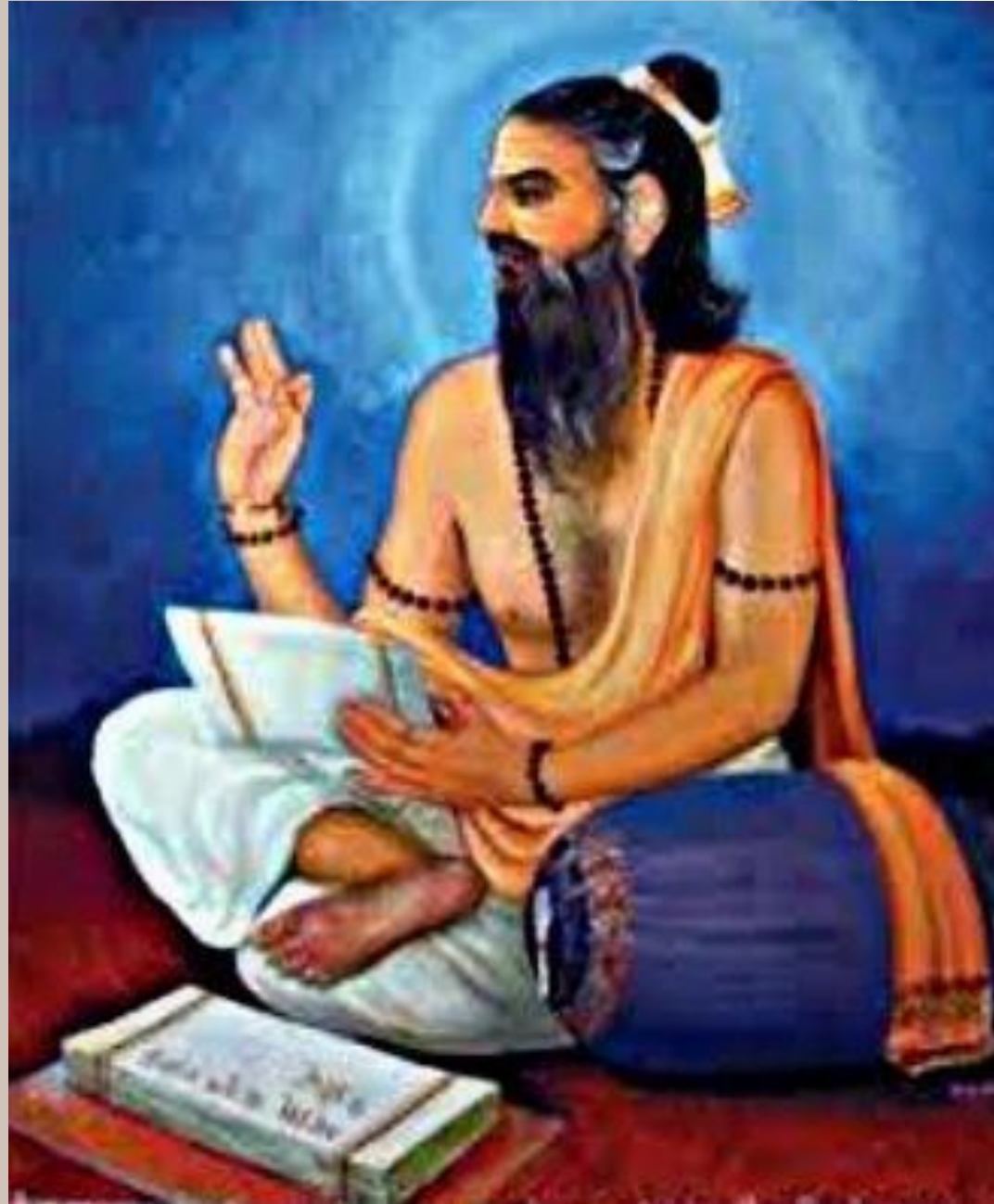
**Sah is a Sanskrit word which means he, Nah which means our, bandhu which means brother or kinsman and janitaa which means father or producer of the universe.**

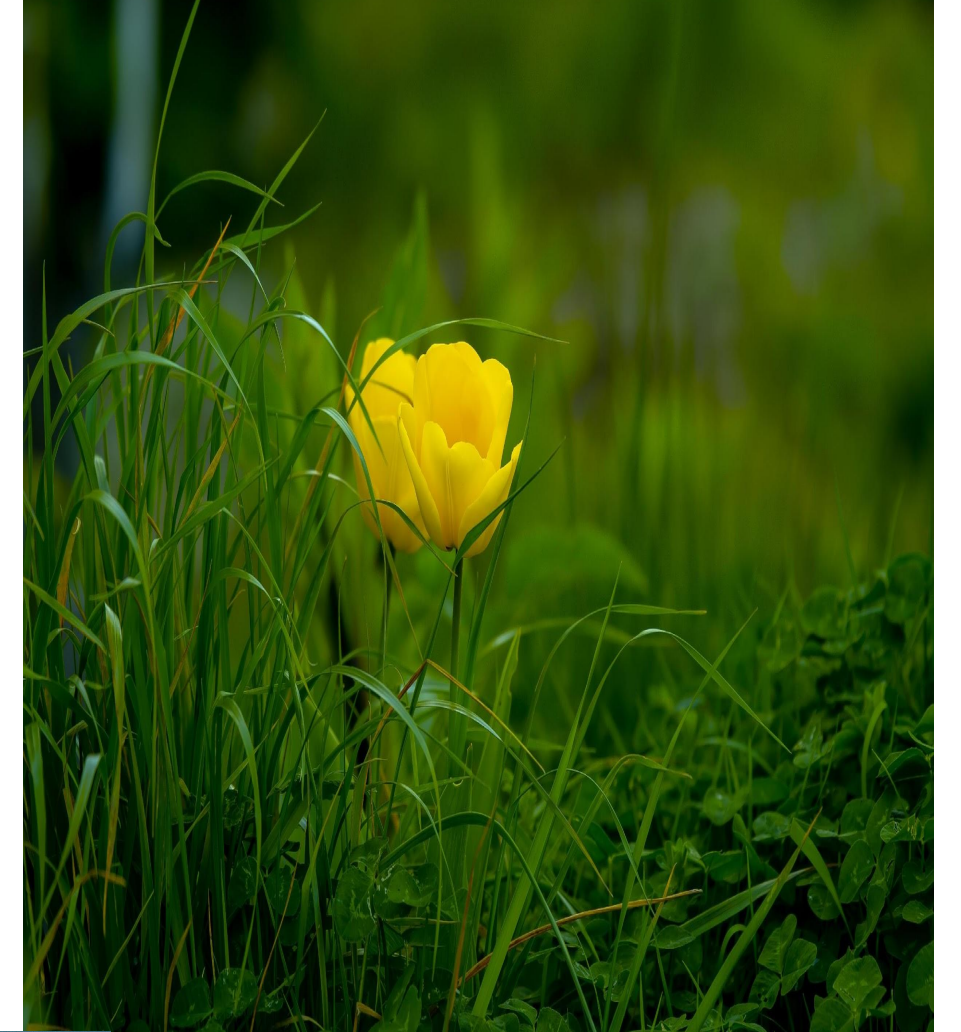
